This year we will be moving to an online enrolment process where each family is required to complete an online enrolment form. As you can imagine our IT team has been very busy, I am hoping this form will be completed by the end of next week so families can begin completing the form, however please be patient. I have also created a clear document for schools to follow to ensure they are following the correct timeline. The full timeline will be sent out once the online enrolment form is completed.

I have attached a copy of Term 2 timeline to ensure you are following along appropriately; please note that this is tailored to government schools therefore some of this information may not be relevant. I have also attached the **transition information pack** which should have been distributed to families by **government** primary schools. If you have not done this can you please do it ASAP, as it is due back to primary schools by **May 29**. Please encourage families to locate their child's designated neighbourhood Government school for Year 7 in 2021 by entering their permanent residential address at www.findmyschool.vic.gov.au.

We will be putting up further information about transition on our website in the coming days, including a virtual tour of the college. I encourage you to share these resources with your school community.
